The season saw the continuation of competitions with the inclusion of teams from Bankstown District Cricket Association at both junior and senior level. The C&WSCA Treasurers Report Season 2023/2024

The Association recorded an operating profit of \$10,373.95 for season 2023-24 as planned when we ordered two seasons of representative player uniforms in advance last financial year which led to a loss result, with a significantly reduced representative uniform spend this season we produced as \$10,373.95 profit to balance up some of our season 2022-23 loss.

Ground hire fees paid by the C&WSCA decreased this season due to our change in policy not to reimburse our affiliated clubs in full for any ground hire invoices they pay for their home grounds which the C&WSCA use. This policy change has benefited the Association as we are paying out less in ground hire fees for the grounds which our clubs are paying increased ground hire fees for, while the C&WSCA use those grounds to play our competitions matches.

Kookaburra provided the C&WSCA \$2,500 in sponsorship as usual, while Anna and Carla our dynamic duo rep mums set record high reps fund raising with a mix of donations, grants, raffles, sausage sizzles at Bunnings and new sponsorships for our representative teams.

Thank-you to all our new representative team's sponsors for their financial support in 2023-24

James Van Gelder (\$2000), One Valencia (\$1000), Xnetit (\$500) and Canterbury BMW (\$500)

The Office of Sports granted \$11,600 and Wests Ashfield Leagues Club granted \$5,750 towards our representative teams thanks to the outstanding efforts Anna and Carla.

Our Winter Development program was partly covered by the fees raised from the players and \$100 per player was contributed by the C&WSCA.

The representative player fees raised in season 2023-24 combined with our representative fund raising, grants and team sponsors funds covered the coaching, gear, training and uniforms expenses of our expanding representative teams programs.

Our season 2023-24 financial year profit of \$10,373.95 is a welcome outcome especially as we've been able to continue providing Clubs \$100 per team financial relief as we started during Covid and have continued to date.

Thank-you to the C&WSCA executive and Life Members Paul Thompson our Honorary Auditor, Dinesh Divakar, Anna Mori and Carla Beheram for your support throughout the season in assisting with the association fund raising and management.

Explanation notes for Profit and Loss Statement

Our season 2023-24 profit of \$10,373.95 was planned by the C&WSCA executive team with the purchase of 2 seasons of representative playing uniforms in 2022-23 to cover 2023-24 in advance. This resulted in our 2022-23 loss being offset by our season 2023-24 profit of \$10,373.95.

While we still assisted all our clubs by maintaining our covid relief, \$100 per team fee reduction (down from \$800 to \$700 per senior team and down from \$700 to \$600 per junior team) plus we continued to pay \$100 towards every player in our Winter Development training program.

Representative Income and Expenses

Representative fees income includes Winter Development and Representative season fees collected from players, funds raising raffles, sausage sizzles at Bunnings BBQs, grants from the Office of Sports and Wests Ashfield Leagues Club plus our new reps sponsors to cover expenses including, payment for cricket equipment, representative clothing, training gear, and programs, trophies, award night functions photos and winter development training.

Winter development costs run over 2 financial years, with income being received in the previous financial year and costs being paid during the current financial year. In season 2023-24 The C&WSCA paid \$100 towards every Winter Development player's training expenses.

Representative expenses continued to increase in season 2023-24 with clothing and coaching, costing more. These costs were covered by the fees each player paid and the fantastic fund raising done by Anna and Carla as detailed in the Treasurer's report.

Administration Costs

These are the everyday costs of running the association namely, phone, internet, paper, printing and the like as incurred in the normal course of association business plus purchases of laptops, printers, mobile phone and internet bill payments as required by the Secretary and our executive committee from time to time.

Clubs Fees

Income received includes affiliation, ground fees, registration, bonds and fines for both senior and junior teams for the season. This income is used to pay for Councils Ground Hire Invoices, Umpires Fees and some of the other administration costs of the C&WSCA.

Association Phone Account

This amount represents the cost of the Association land line, internet connection and the Secretary's I-phone 14 mobile phone purchase in 2023 and his mobile phone and internet bills which has been included in Administration costs as approved by our auditor since 2015 to date
